PIUS XI CATHOLIC HIGH SCHOOL SUMMER CAMP POLICIES

PHONE POLICY:

When we welcome your students to be Popes for the week, we want them to get the full experience! Pius XI is a phone-free school, meaning that no phones will be allowed during camp duration. Phones are not required for any camps, and we hope students will use this time to build community with those around them and embrace all opportunities distraction-free.

LUNCH/SNACK:

All campers are expected to provide their own packed lunch, snack, and water bottle daily each day of camp.

A break will be provided between each camp session, with a longer break for lunch midday. Students will eat with all camp participants and current Pius XI students.

PAYMENT:

Payments must be made in full at the time of registration.

CANCELLATION/WITHDRAWAL POLICY:

Pius XI reserves the right to cancel any camp for any reason, including low enrollment. Should a camp be cancelled, registered families will be notified and will be able to either transfer the amount to another camp with open registration available only paying the difference in cost, or receive a refund. Prior to May 15th, cancellations are eligible for a refund minus a \$10 cancellation fee. After May 15th, should special circumstances arise, please feel free to contact the camp coordination team. Once camps have begun, no refunds for withdrawals will be disbursed. Camp registrations are non transferable.

WAITLIST:

If the camps you are wanting to enroll in are fully booked, please communicate with the camp coordination team so that you may be placed on a waitlist, should any cancellations occur. Should Camp Pius XI contact you regarding an availability in a camp you are on the waitlist for, you have 2 business days to accept the camp placement and officially register before the spot will be released to another camper.

ATTENDANCE:

Daily attendance is encouraged, as camps are focused on building on new skills every day.

Campers should be dropped off 15 minutes before their camp's start time and picked up no later than 15 minutes after their camp's end time.

To ensure the safety and supervision of all campers, students must be in a registered camp session to remain on Pius XI campus.

Rooted in tradition, Pius XI Catholic High School had its beginnings in September 1929 under the direction of the Pallottine Fathers and the School Sisters of St. Francis. The founders taught in three improvised classrooms above the old St. Anthony of Padua Church.

In 1930, the building – which today serves as St. Vincent Pallotti grade school immediately to the North of Pius XI's present location – opened its doors to 35 students. When searching for the name of the new Catholic high school, it was only natural to think of Pope Pius XI, a scholar who championed the cause of Christian education and who had just celebrated his Golden Jubilee in the priesthood. Pius XI Catholic High School was founded to honor this great leader, and our sports teams are proud to be called the "Popes" in honor of the school's namesake ...
